The Challenge to Big Thought

Formerly known as Young Audiences of North Texas, Big Thought (www.bigthought.org) is a learning partnership with the mission of inspiring, empowering, and uniting children through education and the arts. Founded nearly 20 years ago, the organization has grown to include multiple arts and culture-based programs that serve children from preschoolers to teens, as well as educators, families, librarians, and early childhood caregivers.

Big Thought's premise is that a community working together can lift children up and better their lives using arts and culture as tools and catalysts. So, in addition to its full-time staff of about 30 people, the Big Thought community includes major arts organizations, about 60 providers, and more than 200 artists, as well as school boards, corporate sponsors, and individual supporters.

"Like all non-profits, Big Thought's IT spending is constrained," says Virani. "We need to make sure that as much as possible, funding we receive goes back out the door as services for children."

At the same time, Big Thought needs to function as a business, facing many of the same challenges. "We have the same need to realize efficiencies as companies with large IT budgets," he continues. "Protecting our e-mail, servers, and network from viruses is just as big a concern for Big Thought as for any for-profit business."

For quite some time, Big Thought used a McAfee antivirus product. But with Internet and e-mail viruses becoming more numerous, sophisticated, and stealthy, Virani and Big Thought IT Administrator Rob Lynch wanted stronger virus protection than what they were getting.
